Indoor Air Alliance (IAA) is a non-profit organization that works with healthcare providers and their patients to provide in-home environmental screening services focused on the most common environmental triggers that may be present in the home.

These environmental triggers may potentially exacerbate allergies, asthma or act as lung irritants for patients with COPD, Alpha-1 or other respiratory illnesses.

The Healthy Home Survey Report includes:

- Written results in an easy to read format
- Photographs from Visual Survey
- Graphs reporting on each Screening area, where applicable
- Recommendations to help resolve each issue identified

Patients are normally referred to us by their healthcare provider. At the patient's request, we will provide a copy of the report to the healthcare provider as well. The patient pays for our services directly. Reports are normally available within 3 business days after the Healthy Home Survey is completed. The Survey takes between 2 and 3 hours to conduct.

## *Healthy Home Survey*

The Indoor Air Alliance provides affordable indoor air quality evaluations. Each Healthy Home Survey includes a complete visual survey of the home with a particular emphasis on environmental triggers that may be caused by moisture and leaks, air infiltration, HVAC systems, gas appliances, etc. Screening options include:

### **Indoor Air Pollution Screening**

- Carbon Monoxide
- Carbon Dioxide
- Volatile Organic Compounds (VOCs – odors and chemicals)
- Particles (dust)
- Humidity
- Temperature

### **Ductwork Screening**

- Color video inspection of duct interiors
- Exterior visual inspection of ductwork

### **Mold Screening**

- Air sampling
- Carpet sampling
- Visible mold sampling
- Nationally accredited lab results

### **Allergen Screening**

- Cat (Fel d1), Dog (Can f1)
- Mouse (Mus m1), Rat (Rat n1)
- Cockroach (Bla g1, Bla g2)
- Dust mite (Der p1 and Der p2)
- Pollen and other biologicals

### **Radon Screening**

- Recommendations for air sampling
